

# **Jesus, the Truth? Submission Requirements**

## **General**

There is no requirement that submitters be Christian, nor that a particular Christian denominational perspective be held. All submittals will be considered, regardless of the worldview of the submitter. Censorship will only occur if the submittal is clearly uncivilized (i.e. openly hostile, gratuitously violent or sexual, vulgar, etc). Common courtesy will be the hallmark of this publication.

The NCAC is a localized group, thus submitters should reside in Calgary and surrounding area. Submissions from outside this area will be considered, but preference will be given to locals.

All submittals must be original to the author and must be received no later than one month prior to publication.

NCAC receives no income and therefore does not pay for articles.

## **Worldviews in the News / Recommended Links**

Any news article that has a worldview component, particularly if it impinges on the Christian worldview, will be considered. Recommended links must also relate to worldview questions and/or the truth of Christianity. Brief commentary may be added by NCAC members.

## **Letters from the Front**

Approximately 500 words. The intent of this section is to help Christians more effectively and respectfully engage those of other beliefs by sharing real-life stories of successes and failures. Preference will be given to articles submitted by Christians, but similar stories from those of other beliefs will also be considered.

## **Essays**

Approximately 1500 words. Any issue related to the truth of Christianity, written from a Christian or non-Christian perspective will be given equal consideration. Preference will be given to submissions that are intellectually stimulating while remaining accessible to adults of average education and emphasize facts over opinions.
